## PARENT STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT AND COMMITMENT

I have read and agree to fully support and abide by the guidelines and statements set forth.

1. Castle Hills First Baptist School's philosophy is founded on the Word of God and is committed to Christ-centered teaching in all areas of a student's education. Therefore, our goal is to prepare our students for life by implementing, integrating, and fusing Biblical values and principles with academics.
2. We believe that Jesus is the only son of God who was born of a virgin, was crucified, buried, and rose again on the third day. We believe we are saved by grace through faith in Christ and that those who receive Christ as Lord and Savior will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit and eternal life. We are committed to sharing this teaching with our students on a daily basis.
3. The administration will take all responsibility for academic placement.
4. I, the parent/guardian, agree to comply with the Financial Agreement Policies.
5. CHFBS reserves the right to discipline, suspend, or expel a student who is guilty of misconduct. If a student exhibits unproductive behavior that reflects unfavorably on themselves, their peers, or their school, he/she will be held accountable.
6. Students are expected to maintain Christian standards of courtesy, kindness, morality, and honesty and to refrain from profanity, indecent language, gambling, cheating, sexual immorality (including any student who professes to be homosexual/bisexual or is practicing homosexual/bisexual, as well as any student who condones, supports, or otherwise promotes such practices), stealing, the use of any type of tobacco, drugs, alcohol, and pornographic materials, and from participation in occult, unlawful, violent, or destructive acts.
7. In accordance with biblical principles, we as parents agree to partner with the teachers and administration in all matters of school related discipline.
8. Parental grievances must be directed through the proper channels:
  - a. All grievances will be handled in accordance with the principles outlined in Matthew 18:15-17. All persons are to deal with the situation at its source. This usually means initially speaking privately with the particular teacher or appropriate school staff member in a constructive and supportive attempt to get clarification or resolution.
  - b. If, after honest attempts have been made and clarification or resolution has not satisfactorily been reached, then the person proceeds to the next level of authority. This generally means speaking with the Principal/Head Administrator. If satisfaction is not realized by this point, then:
  - c. The person submits their request to the School Board, in writing, at least two weeks in advance of the next regularly scheduled meeting.
  - d. It is understood that the School Board is the court of final appeal. Should the time ever come that we can no longer support the policies and guidelines at CHFBS, we will discretely and politely withdraw our child from Castle Hills First Baptist School.

It is understood that this is a joint agreement between the school, the parents, and the student. The school will enforce these policies and guidelines to the best of our ability. CHFBS also expects the parents to support and enforce these policies and guidelines while the student is associated with Castle Hills First Baptist School during the school term and the summer.
